

## New York Legal Assistance Group CLE Financial Aid Policy

NYLAG offers financial aid to attorneys who wish to attend live courses or utilize available non-traditional format courses, but who are unable to due to their inability to pay.

To apply for financial aid, an attorney must submit a financial aid request in writing at least 7 days in advance of a scheduled live training or when requesting non-traditional format audio CDs or audiotapes. The request should include the course name, the individual's current employment status or yearly income and any other pertinent details regarding the person's inability to pay.

The following guidelines are generally applied when considering a financial aid request:

Unemployed Full scholarship Income below \$25,000 75% discount Income \$25,000 - \$50,000 50% discount No discount

An applicant will receive an answer to his or her request for financial aid within 2 business days of receipt of the request.
